Synopsis:

- Write an HTML page that contains JavaScript code that produces the content of an HTML paragraph
- Read HTML pages on JavaScript tutorial at w3schools

Details:

1. Write an HTML page that contains JavaScript code that produces the content of an HTML paragraph in the HTML page
 - a. The page should be written on your own computer and displayed (opened) by a browser on your computer
 - b. After it works upload the file to your web site and make a link called 'my first Javascript page' from your home page, index.html, to this page.
 - i. It should be placed at the top level of your web site, NOT in the cgi-bin sub-directory
 - c. Email me once your site has page up loaded
 - d. The HTML page should have an HTML paragraph with an 'id' attribute.
 - e. Javascript code should change the content of this paragraph by using this 'id'
 - i. An exact example of how to do this is in the reading assignment on the 'JS How To' page under the heading 'Changing HTML Elements'
 - f. Only changing the content by id will be a valid assignment
2. Read HTML pages JavaScript tutorial at w3schools
 - a. Start at 'JS Introduction': http://www.w3schools.com/js/js_intro.asp
 - b. Read each following section up thru 'JS If...Else':
http://www.w3schools.com/js/js_if_else.asp
 - c. Try the 'Try it yourself' examples as you go. Make changes in these examples to ensure you understand the topic of each page.
 - d. Email any questions you have as others in the class might have the same questions.
